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#### **B. PRACTICAL /CLINICAL**

**One term of three months each in out-patient department and in-patient** department respectively for Case Taking , analysis, evaluation and provisional prescription for case presentation on **ten cases per month**.

\* Each student has to maintain records of *20 worked out cases* (*10 chronic and 10 acute*). The case records should stress following :

1) Case taking,

- 2) Nosological Diagnosis
- 3) Analysis of symptoms,
- 4) General management including diet and regimen, Prognosis, Miasmatic diagnosis,
- 5) State of Susceptibility
- 6) Evaluation of symptoms portraying Totality of Symptoms
- 7) Remedy Selection and Posology
- 8) Second Prescription
  - Each student shall present at least *01 case* in the departmental Symposium/Seminar
